## AN IMPACTFUL YEAR: 2024!

The Bethel Fall after-school program concluded on December 9th, with 97 students attending regularly in the fall. Thanks to our partners from the ABWMs and numerous individual supporters, every student received a Christmas shoebox gift to take home. Overall, the 2024 student program was a tremendous success, serving 138 students through our after-school and summer programs. Over 35 students participated in our VBS program, where they learned important biblical principles. We also had 10 teenagers as volunteers and staff during the year, while more than 50 students joined our broader volunteer teams, contributing in various capacities to our programs at BNC. This included participants from the Piper School Basketball team, the 4 Ten group from the ABC Churches, a student team from FBC Boone, IA, and many others. Additionally, after-school students participated in conflict resolution training and had the chance to engage with guest speakers. Elementary students received help with homework and reading, while middle schoolers developed essential social skills through play and interaction. High school students enjoyed building relationships through career and college discussions and fieldtrips.

We remained open until the 20th of the month before closing for the Christmas and New Year break. During this time, we successfully assisted 2051 individuals, representing 357 households, including 873 children and 167 seniors.

This month also served as a powerful reminder of the incredible impact Bethel has on our community, made possible by the generous contributions from you and many others, both near and far. Despite facing significant food insecurity and limited resources, we came together as a community and concluded the year having served **11770 individuals**.
