We thank God for being so faithful in providing all of our needs in 2022 and for bringing us into a New Year that is full of hope and promises! We achieved most of our goals and touched many lives last year because you supported us in prayer and made financial donations to Bethel Neighborhood Center. We are committed to working with more children and youth, senior citizens, and community members in this New Year. We need your help more than ever this year as applying for grants has become increasingly competitive for small organizations like us.



With the help we received from Kansas University Health Systems, local businesses, churches, and individuals, we provided Christmas presents to 66 families, 86 children, and 27 senior citizens last December.
